

YOUTH Transitional Shelter

Transitional Shelter is a safe place to stay- transitional housing- with financial assistance and wrap around supportive services for youth and young adults experiencing homelessness. Also provides up to 6 months of temporary housing as participants are assisted to move to permanent housing as quickly as possible.
