

## Street to Home Phase 2: A New Playbook to Eliminate Street Sleeping

**Street to Home Phase 2 is a \$28 million public-private initiative to maintain closure of Downtown encampments and expand proven interventions across the community.**

With new public investments totaling \$20M and philanthropic contributions, Street to Home Phase 2 will ramp up in March 2026 in preparation for FIFA. Phase 2 expands strategies to prevent people from sleeping outside by offering real pathways off the streets—combining homelessness, mental health, and enforcement responses. Through this work, **an additional 1,100+ individuals will exit homelessness into treatment, recovery, and housing.**

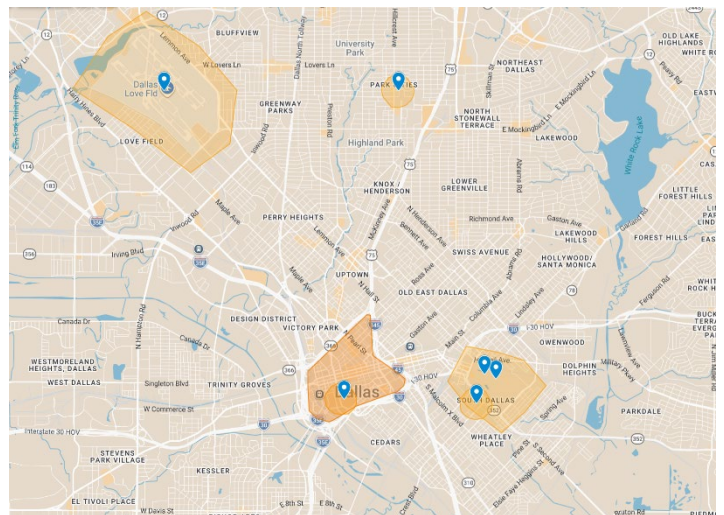
### What We're Doing to Support Permanent Pathways Off the Street

- **Integrated Street Response, Connected to Immediate Placement Options**  
Rapid engagement connects people to shelter, housing, and treatment
- **Scaling Exits from Shelter to Ensure More Come Inside**  
Shelters move more people quickly onto tailored exit pathways (freeing up capacity)
- **Complex Needs Workgroup for People with Severe Mental Illness**  
Coordinated solutions for people with severe mental health/substance use issues

**Preparing for FIFA:** Dallas' commitment to ending street homelessness began well before being named a FIFA World Cup host city. Street to Home Phase II builds on that foundation — ensuring the city is prepared to welcome thousands of visitors while sustaining long-term progress. Phase II deploys targeted engagement at priority locations to prevent street sleeping and connect individuals to permanent pathways off the street.

### Intensifying Integrated Street Response for FIFA to Respond to and Prevent Street Sleeping

- **Rapid response outreach teams** including 25 homeless system outreach workers deployed to immediately engage individuals observed sleeping outside or assembling structures
- **Targeted geographic focus**, including a ¼-mile radius around major transportation hubs, DART stations, the FIFA broadcasting center, game locations, and comprehensive Downtown coverage
- **Expanded real-time coordination** between Housing Forward, the City of Dallas Office of Emergency Management & Crisis Response (including RIGHT Care), and the Dallas Police Department HOT Team



Engagement efforts are already active in key locations and will scale steadily through June, alongside increasingly frequent partner coordination meetings.

## Street to Home Background

Street to Home Phase 1 launched in 2024 as a coordinated strategy to address homelessness and enhance safety and vibrancy in Downtown Dallas. Led by Housing Forward and the All Neighbors Coalition, in partnership with the City of Dallas and Downtown Dallas Inc. it aligned outreach, shelter, behavioral health, and public safety partners to prevent street sleeping and resolve encampments, establishing the foundation for expansion under Phase 2.

**Phase 1 Impacts** include permanent resolution of all Downtown encampments, 87% decline in daily street counts, and \$48M avoided in jail, hospital and crisis system use.

**Phase 2 Scales Permanent Exits Out of Homelessness** Via the Following Funded Activities Delivered by Contracted Partners:

- Rental Assistance from 1 to 12 months
- Case Management & Integrated Mental Health Services
- Complex Needs Coordination
- Flexible funding to streamline pathways off the street
